



Happy July from a sunny UK. It is so unusual for us to enjoy such a prolonged period of lovely summer weather here in the UK and so we are making the best of it. While we are enjoying the sunshine here, in Sierra Leone it is raining hard and so the outreaches are very difficult.

Ali has been to Uganda for 2 weeks with Roger London from Watchmen International (WI), an organisation we are directors of. He has been involved in a water filter distribution at the Kyaka 2 Refugee Camp and a WI International Team Leaders meeting. While Ali has been away I have been very busy decorating.

The weather in Kailahun is making it difficult to do the outreaches right now but still our team continues to do all they can to proclaim the good news of Jesus in and around Kailahun town. Our team have been praying and seeking God on how to best follow up in the communities where they have previously visited with the Jesus film and how best to disciple those who are newly converted. We need more funds so as our 'workers' can do this follow up work, in these communities, which is so important, we really need to ensure we are making disciples and not just converts. 

June Outreaches

Below is a brief report from each of the outreaches that took place in March and April. Be Blessed.

Morfindor

Our team visited Morfindor on 17th June 2018. Morfindor is a place very close to our hearts. James Fatorma our very dear friend who tragically died last December was from this village and we visited this village with him on numerous occasions. At James' 40 days (post death) ceremony, which we attended, Pastor Fullah promised the community that Maranatha COM would come and do an outreach here. We are thrilled that this has now taken place and many people responded to the gospel.



Konjo

Konjo is about 15 miles from Kailahun Town and 2 miles from the Liberian border. Our team visited this village on the 28th June where they saw God move in a powerful way and once again many people committed their lives to Jesus. The people in this village are living in abject poverty with no safe water and no health care facilities.

Benduma

On the 30th June our team travelled to Benduma which is 10 miles from Kailahun Town just 3 miles from the Guinea border here, Pastor Fullah preached about the soon return of Jesus, again many people responded including a lady who has for many years led the people to worship "the marine spirit" and is said to be married to "Musa" the Marine Spirit. The team will be returning to follow up in this village very soon. God really is doing some amazing things, please keep praying.



Maranatha Motor Bike

We now have our very own motorbike, this means that outreach costs will reduce as we will have one less bike to hire for each outreach. This bike will also be used for follow up in the villages. Thank you to The Norman Whiteley Trust who helped with set up funds to facilitate the work of Maranatha COM and provided the funds for us to be able to supply this motorbike.
